**Baptisms:** Parents wishing to have their child baptized must be registered and active members for at least three months and are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance.

**Confirmation:** Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

**Marriage:** Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor. (If either in the couple has been previously married, an annulment by the Church may be necessary)

**Anointing of the Sick:** Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

**Visits by Priest, Deacon, Parish Care Volunteers** In addition to Fr. Ferguson, Fr. Jeffrey, and Deacon Mike, we have trained volunteers who will visit and bring Communion to you or a loved one at home, in rehab or nursing home, or in the hospital. Please let us know if you or someone you know would like to have these visits! (And please make sure we know when you or a loved one are homebound or hospitalized!)

**New Emergency Line** - For *serious* sacramental emergencies, ER visits, pending deaths, etc. an emergency line has been established. This number is not for any regular parish business but for true emergencies only. Call 419-673-6720 to leave a message that will be routed directly to Father Ferguson.

We pray for all who entered the Catholic Church at Easter as well as for our PSR students preparing for First Communion and Confirmation.

**First Communion** will be celebrated on Saturday, May 18 at 11:00 am  
**Confirmation** will be celebrated on Wednesday, May 22 at 7:00 pm with our diocese's new bishop, Bishop Robert Brennan.

- \* There are no PSR Classes this Sunday, April 28.
- \* There will be classes on May 5, 12, and 19.
- \* There is a rehearsal for First Communion (with a parent) at 9:45 am on Sunday, May 12.
- \* There is a rehearsal for Confirmation (with sponsors) on Sunday, May 19, at 12:15 pm.
- \* Confirmation Candidates will meet with Bishop Brennan before the Confirmation Mass at 6:15 pm; Mass is at 7:00.
- \* The five Altar Servers for the Confirmation Mass will need to be at the church at 6:15 also, to meet with the MC who will direct each of their duties.

**Liturgical Ministries** Because of summer vacations and a shortage of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion for the Sunday Masses, we will not be offering the Precious Blood on Sunday throughout the summer months of June, July, and August. As it is now, with offering the Precious Blood, we need to have six stations - two for the Precious Body and two for the Precious Blood in the main body of the church and one for each in the parish hall. In June, July, and August we will be needing only three to distribute: the Priest and the Deacon (or EMC if Deacon Mike is not there) to distribute in the main church and one EMC in the hall. We need to have at least five more volunteers to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion for the Sunday Masses in order to resume offering the Precious Blood. Please let us know in the office if you would like to be trained as an EMC!  
*If you or your child has a medical intolerance to the host, please see Fr. Ferguson!*
