We are celebrating the Triduum - Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil, here at Our Lady of Lourdes this year. (Triduum is celebrated in the odd numbered years at OLL and even numbered years at ICC)

The **MIME Stations of the Cross**, presented by the members of our High School Youth Group, are on **Good Friday at Noon.**

**A special invitation for Catholic Converts!** New this year, as part of the RCIA program, we will have a gathering called *Mystagogia* (mist-a-go-jha) - A deepening of our understandings in the mysteries of our faith and their impact on our lives. If you are a convert - someone who has come into the Catholic Church as an adult - and would like to share your experiences and journey of faith with other converts and new members of the Church, we would like to invite you to the gathering on **Sunday, April 30** in the parish hall at 6:30 pm. **The Confessional** (accessed through the musician's area) is completed! Thank you Mike Moloney! Confessions are heard Saturdays at 6:00 pm or by appointment. You will know if you may enter by noting whether there is a green or red light above the door - enter when the light is green. When you enter, you may stay anonymous or ask the priest to open the screen for face-to-face Confession. You may kneel or sit. **There will be a special hours available for celebrating the sacrament of Reconciliation on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 23, from 1:00 - 3:00 pm.**



It is traditional to pray the Divine Mercy Novena (Nine days of prayer) to begin on Good Friday and end on Divine Mercy Sunday, the Sunday after Easter. In addition to the wealth of information available on the internet, we have printed Divine Mercy Novena booklets if you would like to pray this novena; it is specifically for praying for other people!

**Baptisms:** Parents wishing to have their child baptized must be registered and active members for at least three months and are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance.

**Confirmation:** Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

**Marriage:** Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor. (If either in the couple has been previously married, an annulment by the Church may be necessary)

**Anointing of the Sick:** Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

**Visits by Priest, Deacon, Parish Care Volunteers** In addition to Fr. Dave, Fr. Jeffrey, and Deacon Mike, we have trained volunteers who will visit and bring Communion to you or a loved one at home, in rehab or nursing home, or in the hospital. Please let us know if you or someone you know would like to have these visits! (And please make sure we know when you or a loved one are homebound or hospitalized!)

**RCIA:** The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the office for more information. RCIA is Sundays at 6:30 pm, September - April. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the parish office.
