There are MANY Parish, Diocesan, and National Designated Collections that only our envelope users are supporting. PLEASE pick up a box of envelopes to see all the opportunities there are for caring for our Catholic brothers and sisters near and far! *See below for the list of January envelopes.*

We closed the books on December 31 and will begin issuing 2018 contributions statements soon. Any contributions *received* on or after January 1 are credited to 2019 Offerings, even if the check is dated prior to January 1. The Diocese will send BAA Statements directly to those whose contributions were \$250 or more. The Parish will include BAA statements of those contributions less than \$250 with the parish statements.

**January Envelopes**, in addition to regular Sunday offerings:

Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God Holy Day; Gift for Seminarians (1x a year); Parish Capital Fund (Monthly); Propagation of the Faith (National, 1x a year).

Instead of charging our families a fee for the Parish School of Religion, our parish expects everyone to support the education of our parish children with their contributions and specifically through the quarterly **Parish Religious Education Fund** envelope.

**Baptisms:** Parents wishing to have their child baptized must be registered and active members for at least three months and are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance.

**Confirmation:** Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

**Marriage:** Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor. (If either in the couple has been previously married, an annulment by the Church may be necessary)

**Anointing of the Sick:** Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

**Visits by Priest, Deacon, Parish Care Volunteers** In addition to Fr. Ferguson, Fr. Jeffrey, and Deacon Mike, we have trained volunteers who will visit and bring Communion to you or a loved one at home, in rehab or nursing home, or in the hospital. Please let us know if you or someone you know would like to have these visits! (And please make sure we know when you or a loved one are homebound or hospitalized!)

**New Emergency Line** - For *serious* sacramental emergencies, ER visits, pending deaths, etc. an emergency line has been established. This number is not for any regular parish business but for true emergencies only. Call 419-673-6720 to leave a message that will be routed directly to Father Ferguson.
